

Fair Play Principles - Media

When we attend an orienteering event we will behave with fairness, honesty and a spirit of friendship. We will respect each other, athletes, team officials, spectators, event organisers, and volunteers who make the event possible.

When applying for accreditation to the event we will:

- Be familiar with the latest version of competition rules, event information bulletins and embargoed areas.
- Sign a confidentiality agreement to access confidential event information.
- Declare any potential conflict of interests to the event organiser if we have a personal relationship with athletes, team officials or event officials.

Before the event we will:

- Work together with the event organisers to maximise media coverage.
- Only use event information that is publicly available via the event website and bulletins.
- Respect the integrity and intent of embargo rules and accept that entry to the competition terrain outside the event arena is only allowed only with special permission from the event organisers.
- Have the opportunity to take part in the model events.

During the event competitions we will:

- Follow all instructions from the event organisers.
- Only access the competition terrain with permission and guidance by the organisers and keep as quiet as possible in the terrain.
- Not disturb competitors nor supply any visual or oral information whatsoever to athletes.
