HOW TO GET TO ORSA GRÖNKLITT

CLASSES AND PARTICIPATION

JWOC

Each federation may enter seven (7) men and seven (7) women and unlimited number of team officials. For each competition each federation may enter six (6) men and six (6) women and two (2) relay teams in each class. **Classes: M20/W20**

EYOC

Each federation may enter four (4) men and four (4) women and unlimited number of team officials. For each competition each federation may enter four (4) men and four (4) women in each class. **Classes: M17/W17**

NOC

Each federation may enter seven (7) men and seven (7) women and unlimited number of team officials. For each competition each federation may enter six (6) men and six (6) women and two (2) relay teams in each class. Nordic countries may also enter 15 men and 15 women each from national clubs. **Classes: M21/W21**

Open races

Open classes all days, entry at competition office. Also open competitions as follow:

Tuesday Jan 27 th -	Sprint, M/W18
Friday Jan 30 th -	Middle distance, M/W21 (WRE), M/W20 and M/W18 (Swedish Ski-O Cup).
Saturday 31 st -	Relay, M/W18

ENTRY

Entry (form B) with names of competitors and team officials shall be made **January 15th 2009** at the latest.

- OPPORTUNITIES FOR TRAINING** There will be possibilities for training continuously after the snow comes, before and during the races for both cross-country and ski-O in Mora, app. 30 km south of Orsa Grönklitt. The area for training is located among the last 10 km of Vasaloppet. The last 10 km of Vasaloppet is likely prepared and skiable at this time of year. - TERRAIN** Alpine low terrain with both less and detailed contour, mostly forest and partly big marshes. Height differences approximately up to 50 m. The competition area is based at a cross-country ski center with extensive extra trails specially for ski-o to be added.
- MAPS** Digital printed ski-O maps, surveyed 2008, scale 1:5000 (sprint), 1:10 000 (middle distance and relay), 1:15 000 (long distance), contour interval 5 m.
