SORIA. BEYOND YOUR IMAGINATION !

The Spanish Orienteering Federation welcomes all the European nations to Soria to celebrate the **9**th **European Youth Orienteering Championships 2010**.

Location

The city of Soria is located in the region of Castilla y León, 220 km north-east of the centre of Spain. The city of Soria has a population of 39078 - nearly 40% of the population of the province. Situated on the Duero River in the east of the autonomous community, the city is noted for its walls and a number of architecturally distinctive churches

Landscape

The physical geography of Soria is made up of different types of land and each of these its own special



features. Thus, we can find the sierra of Urbión in the North, with the source of the river Duero rises; the Moncayo mountain in the East; big forests in the West; fields of grain in the South-East; moors in the Castilian meseta in the South and the riverside in the central part of the province.

History

Throughout the centuries Soria has been keeping traces of its history, from Paleolithic dinosaurs' footprints remains of Celtiberians, Romans, Visigoths, Muslims and Christians. Two examples of historical places are Numancia, conquered by the Romans in the 2nd century B.C. after years of brave resistance by its inhabitants, and Calatañazor where Muslims and Christians fought in the 11th century. The abundance of Romanesque monuments shows the flowering of this region in the Middle Ages.

Heritage

The artistic richness of Soria is one of its main attractions. Many towns, like Medinaceli, form groups of artistic and historical interest and offer visitors the opportunity to view architectural treasures. Soria offers the art-loving tourist plenty of examples of all kind of styles and ages, beginning with the cave paintings in Valonsadero and including the beautiful Romanesque churches with detailed porticos, the elegant Gothic cathedral of El Burgo de Osma and the outstanding Mozarabic hermitage of San Baudelio.

Gastronomy

The cuisine of Soria offers delicious and unique meals to its guests. We can enjoy the typical *torreznos* (fried bacon seasoned with paprika...), *calderetas* (stewed lamb or veal with potatoes), *migas pastoriles* (fried pieces of stale bread with little *torreznos*), and a variety of sweets and desserts, including the famous sweet or salted butter. Guests will savoir delicious hunting dishes, mushrooms, cured pork meat stuffed in a kind of sausages (like chorizo, salami...), classified wines under *Denominación de Origen* (guarantee of origin and quality of the wine) and other local products cooked using the best of both the traditional and the modern cuisine.

7. Classes and participation restrictions

The European Youth Orienteering Championships are open to:

- Women 16 (W16): up to 16 years of age, born in 1994 and later
- Women 18 (W18): 17-18 years of age, born in 1992 and 1993, and later
- Men 16 (M16): up to 16 years of age, born in 1994 and later
- Men 18 (M18): 17-18 years of age, born in 1992 and 1993, and later

All competitors must have a valid passport of the country they are representing.

A competitor may represent only one national federation during any one calendar year

Competitors participate at their own risk. Accident insurance shall be the responsibility of their Federation or of themselves, according to national regulations

Each nation can enter a maximum of of 4 runners in each class. Up to 4 officials (team leaders) are allowed per nation.

Sprint event and long distance event: 4 competitors per national team in each class. Relay: 3 legs, one national team in each class.


LONG DISTANCE RACE

With reference to the IOF Competition Rules (article 26.6), the listed areas are embargoed for all potential EYOC 2010 team members (runners, team leader, coach, etc.) as well as others with strong links to EYOC squads.

Spelt out in detail it means that:

- No organized orienteering activities may take place in these areas.
- No training sessions, i.e. running/races, testing routes.
- No-one with potential connection to a team (athlete or other function) may visit the embargoed areas.

SPECIAL INFORMATION ABOUT SPRINT

The area where the sprint race will take place is the city of Soria, parks and surroundings. In order to allow a fair competition for all nations, all participants <u>may walk</u> through these streets and parks in the days previous to the technical meeting 3 (July 3rd).

It is not allowed to set up running tests in Soria in order to evaluate the possible route choices in the sprint race.


Embargoes of all the EYOC2010 Embargoed Areas are valid until all the EYOC2010 Events in these areas are finished.







10. Maps and terrains




Due to the big extensions of the forests in this particular region of Soria (Comarca de Pinares – Region of Pine Forests), this territory is also known as "The Green Sea".

Long distance

- Map: La Cruz de Piedra, scale 1:10000, 5m contours, surface 7.5 km².
- Map maker: Juan Manuel García Crespo.
- Location: This area is 50 Km from the Event Centre in Soria (45 min)
- Never used before for orienteering.
- Terrain form: Mountain terrain with deep valleys and rock elements located from 1050 to 1200 meters above sea level,
- Vegetation: 90% of the terrain is covered with pine forest, some areas with undergrowth vegetation (rockrose).
- Runnability: Combinations of areas with very good runnability with other zones of poor to bad runnability due to the rocky outcrops and dense undergrowth.
- Visibility: 70% of good visibility areas.





Softa-Spath Lettuly-4th/vly2010











Relay

- Map: Valonsandero-Oeste, scale 1:10000, 5m contours, surface 5 km².
- Map maker: Bernardo Nanclares Izcara.
- Terrain: An oak tree forest full of stones and rock details located from 1000 to 1100 meters above sea level.
- Location: This area is 10 km from the Event Centre in Soria
- Never used before for orienteering.
- Terrain form: Smooth relief, with little valleys towards water courses. Rock elements are the hallmark of this terrain, located in parallel structures as if they were "stone streets"









Vegetation: 50% of the terrain is covered by oak forest, combined with open and semi open areas. There are small rocks near the elements that impede the visibility; in other places near these rocky elements you can detect some areas of thick vegetation which greatly hampers access and visibility. Runnability:





70% of outstanding runnability, lawn terrain. 30% of rocky outcrops, combining smooth with sharp (almost vertical) slopes in the different sides of the outcrops.

- Visibility: Due to the vegetation to the rock elements, 70% of good visibility areas.
- Paths and roads: Abundance of small paths.

Sprint

- Map: Soria, scale 1:5000, 2.5 contours, surface 1,1 km².
- Map maker: Mario Vidal Triquell
- Terrain: Good runnability, moderate slopes and plenty of details.
- Location: City of Soria, parks and surroundings.
- Never used before for orienteering.









11. Punching system

All events will be organized using SPORTident electronic punching system. The SI cards will be provided by the organizers.

12. Training opportunities

EYOC 2010 organizers offer to each team the possibility to make use of the training sessions, which have been prepared in the same region as the Championships and in terrains relevant for the long distance race.







These six trainings (T1 to T6) which have been planned by the EYOC 2010 organizers are ready, and the controls are marked with orange ribbons in the forest.

With the aim of offering a fast and useful service, the trainings maps have been generated in high resolution PDF files (one file with the training course and another file with a blank map). They will be forwarded by email as soon as the teams have filled out the on-line form available on the EYOC 2010 website. At this point the organizers will forward an extra form in order to facilitate the teams with the transport and accommodation arrangements during the official EYOC 2010 training period (June 27th Sunday – June 30th Wednesday), and any time before this.

The cost of each training (both PDF files) is 10 (per country) and will be charged together with the registration fee to be paid in the final registration. With this payment the teams have the right to print as many maps as they need for the training period. Please note that transfer of the training map files to other teams is not allowed and that they may not be used for any other competitions.

Soria is not far from several important airports:

Madrid 225 km
 Barcelona 450 km
 Bilbao 235 km







Zaragoza 168 km

There are 5 trains and 10 buses per day to Madrid.

If needed the organizers will be very pleased to help the national teams to organize the transportation inside Spain.

Arriving to Soria from Madrid

Concerning transportation, the cost of a complete bus (50-55 seats) is around 500 Euros per trip from Madrid to Soria.

If we cannot group you with another team, the maximum cost for a team of 20 members will be around 50 Euros, round ticket per person. If there are two teams, then the cost is half of that price.

Depending of the number of teams requesting transportation, we expect an average price per person around 20 Euros per trip.

Public transportation is around $30 \in \text{round ticket excluding metro in Madrid and local bus at Soria, but it is less convenient as there are only five-six trips per day and it will take you at least one hour and a half longer.$

Transport during the competition days

Organizers will provide transport to and from the model events and to and from the EYOC events and official races, from Thursday 1st July to Sunday 4th. If your team do not wish to use the official competition transport, you must inform the organizers in order to be supplied with a parking card for your team vehicles instead.

(NEW INFORMATION)

It is allowed for the teams to use their own transport during the competition at their own expense and risk. EYOC teams will receive parking cards and maps with descriptions of the routes to all competitions arenas.

Please note that only vehicles with WOC parking cards can be parked in the special parking zones at the event arenas. Instructions provided by the organizers must be strictly followed.

If any team with his own transport wants to use the official transport, this information must be provided to the organizers in advance.

Transport during the training days (NEW INFORMATION)

Transport in the training period may also be requested, the price for one day transport per person will be 10 Euros. Information about team training schedule must be provided to the organizers in order to put in order the bus transport between accommodations and training areas.


